



Court Status Board Protocol

Unique to the RCYBA Early Classic Presented by Scheels in 2020 is the use of court status boards. In response to our facilities having a 250-person capacity, we need to limit the number of individuals inside at all times. Coaches, players, parents, guardians, grandparents, spectators, etc... will not be allowed into the facility until their game time is up and their assigned court is ready to be played on. In order for courts to be ready, the previous game's players, coaches, and all spectators must have left the facility; team benches/chairs need to also have been disinfected by score keepers.

Below is a visual representation of how Court Status Boards should be read. Take note of the game time that is displayed. The time displayed is for the upcoming set of games, not the current games that are being played. Depending on if the court is ready for use, there will be a red or green circle. Red for not ready. Green for ready. Once the green circle has been updated for your upcoming game, gather all individuals with wristbands and be ready to enter the facility together. If an individual has to enter late, they need to tell the door keepers which team they are with, which they will then determine if the individual is able to come in. This will be based on how many have already entered for that team. Individuals will not be allowed into facilities unless they have a mask and a wristband.
