Eligibility Criteria for Nominees

- Athlete must perform their sport and (ongoing) achievement during the 2023 calendar year. This may not include the entire season but the majority of it.
- Athlete must be of an amateur status.

Nominee Contact Info:

- Athletes of any age are eligible for nomination.
- Athletes may participate in any type of sport to be considered for selection.
- All nominees must reside or attend a school within a 30 mile radius of the Rochester community. Nominees that live within a 30-mile radius, but attend a school outside of the boundary are still eligible. Eligible surrounding communities: Byron, Chatfield, Dodge Center, Dover-Eyota, Fillmore, Fountain, Goodhue, Grand Meadow, Hayfield, Kasson-Mantorville, Lake City, Lewiston-Altura, Pine Island, Plainview-Elgin-Millville, Spring Valley, Stewartville, St. Charles, Wanamingo, West Concord, Wykoff, Zumbrota-Mazeppa.
- Collegiate/Post High School athletes are now eligible for the Post-Secondary Athlete of the Year but must have graduated from a high school located in the 30 mile radius as defined above. These individuals will no longer qualify for Male or Female Athlete of the Year.
- Athletes must be in good standing with their respective school.
